Day 1 Winnipeg – Minneapolis

Our tour to the Tulip Time Festival and Mackinac Island begins as we travel south through Grand Forks and Fargo for our overnight in Minneapolis.

Day 2 Minneapolis – Schaumburg

Today we travel along the edge of the Wisconsin Dells to south of Schaumburg for the night.

Day 3 Schaumburg – Holland area

Known around the world for its annual **TULIP TIME FESTIVAL**, Holland provides a day of spectacular scenery and entertainment. This morning we start with a visit to the **VELDHEER TULIP GARDENS**. These gardens show-off millions of tulips in a setting of windmills. This afternoon, attend the uniquely charming **VOLKSPARADE**.

This evening, enjoy the **DUTCH HERITAGE SHOW** whose performers will entertain you with Dutch costumes, songs, dances and much more. (D)

Day 4 Holland area

We will visit **WINDMILL ISLAND**, which is home to America's one and only 200 year-old working Dutch windmill. Also watch the **KLOMPEN DANCERS** perform a variety of Dutch dances in full Dutch costume.

Day 5 Holland – Mackinac Island

Today we embark on a **HYDROPLANE FERRY** crossing to Mackinac Island. Step back in time to a place where transportation is limited to horse and buggy, bicycle or foot. Surrounded on all sides by water, Mackinac Island has managed to escape the changes of time.

Day 6 Mackinac Island

We'll start off our morning with a **HORSE-DRAWN CARRIAGE TOUR** of the Island. Visit an authentic Carriage Museum, stunning **VICTORIAN SUMMER HOMES** and marvel at the breathtaking views. Afterward, you are free to explore the island on your own. Take a stroll through the historic downtown with its fascinating old buildings or take time to learn about the island's history with a visit to Fort Mackinac.

Day 7 Mackinac Island – Marquette

After a ferry ride to the mainland, we drive along the north shore of Lake Michigan and overnight in the resort town of Marquette, located on the south shore of Lake Superior.

Day 8 Marquette – Grand Rapids

Entering Wisconsin your journey continues along the south rim of Lake Superior to Grand Rapids, MN. The last night of this unforgettable tour includes a **FEHR-WAY FAREWELL DINNER** in Grand Rapids.

Day 9 Grand Rapids – Winnipeg
