#### Day 1 Winnipeg – Thunder Bay

Welcome to one of Fehr-Way's most popular tours. Stop at Kakabeka Falls.

#### Day 2 Thunder Bay – Sault Ste. Marie

Today we travel east across Ontario along the rugged north shore of Lake Superior. Visit the **TERRY FOX MONUMENT**.

#### Day 3 Sault Ste. Marie – Ottawa (2 nights)

In Sudbury, home of INCO, you will see the huge replica Big Nickel. Later today you arrive in the nation's capital; Ottawa, for a two night stay.

#### Day 4 Ottawa Area

A **GUIDED TOUR** of **OTTAWA** includes Parliament Hill, the Rideau Canal, and a drive by the homes of the Prime Minister and the Governor General. On your free afternoon enjoy a cruise on the Rideau Canal or shopping at Byward Market.

#### Day 5 Ottawa – Quebec City (2 nights)

A short drive along the Ottawa River brings us to **MONTREAL**, where a **GUIDED TOUR** includes **NOTRE DAME BASILICA, ST. JOSEPH'S ORATORY AND OLD MONTREAL**. Enjoy a two night stay in North America's oldest walled city.

#### Day 6 Quebec City Area

Step into history as a **GUIDED TOUR** reveals the landmarks of the French regime, including the Plains of Abraham, and Place Royale. The afternoon is free to explore old Quebec. Tonight we will enjoy a French Canadian meal at a **SUGAR SHACK**. (D)

#### Day 7 Quebec City – Fredericton

Today we follow the scenic southern shore of the St. Lawrence River, with a stop in St. Jean Port Joli, the woodcarving capital of Quebec. The capital city of New Brunswick is your home for the night. *En route* a stop in Hartland, N.B. to see the **WORLD'S LONGEST COVERED BRIDGE**.



**Day 8 Fredericton –  
Prince Edward Island (2 nights)**

Enjoy coastal views on a morning drive in **FUNDY NAT'L PARK**. You'll stop at **HOPEWELL ROCK**. Travel on to **MAGNETIC HILL** in Moncton. Your journey continues across to P.E.I. on **CONFEDERATION BRIDGE**; the world's longest bridge over ice forming waters. Enjoy your two night stay on beautiful Prince Edward Island.

**Day 9 Prince Edward Island Area**  
A **FULL DAY GUIDED TOUR IN P.E.I.** will highlight fabled **ANNE OF GREEN GABLES HOME** and North Rustico Harbor. In the capital **CHARLOTTETOWN** visit **PROVINCE HOUSE**, the birthplace of Confederation. Tonight enjoy one of P.E.I.'s famous mouth-watering **LOBSTER DINNERS**. (D)

**Day 10 Prince Edward Island –  
Cape Breton Island (2 nights)**  
Board the ferry to cross Northumberland



strait to Pictou, NS. After crossing the Canso Causeway, you visit the **ALEXANDER GRAHAM BELL MUSEUM** in Baddeck.

**Day 11 Cape Breton Island Area**  
Imagine yourself in the highlands of Scotland as you follow the Cabot Trail, through **CAPE BRETON HIGHLANDS NAT'L PARK**. Lush green mountains, deep gorges and sandy beaches make the **CABOT TRAIL** one of North America's most spectacular drives.

**Day 12 Cape Breton –  
Halifax / Dartmouth (2 nights)**  
Begin the day with tea at **RITA MACNEIL'S TEAHOUSE** followed by a visit to **SHERBROOKE VILLAGE**, a restored lumbering and mining town, located on the rustic east shore of Nova Scotia. Early evening you arrive in Halifax, the capital of Nova Scotia.

**Day 13 Halifax Area**  
Famed **CITADEL HILL** and Titanic historic sites are among the interesting places you visit on the **TOUR OF HALIFAX** today. This afternoon enjoy a leisurely drive along the Lighthouse Route to **PEGGY'S COVE**, an authentic 19th century fishing village, and visit its lighthouse.

**Day 14 Halifax - Saint John**  
Travelling via the Annapolis Valley you visit **GRAND-PRÉ**, where Longfellow's 'Evangeline' is immortalized. Then it's on to Canada's oldest incorporated city of Saint John. View the **REVERSING FALLS**.

**Day 15 Saint John - Gorham**  
Entering the United States at Calais, Maine, you head for the fabulous White Mountains of New Hampshire.

**Day 16 Gorham - Albany**  
Today you enter the state of Vermont and stop at the **MAPLE GROVE** gift shop. Our overnight stop is in the capital of New York state.

**Day 17 Albany - Niagara Falls**  
You arrive this afternoon in the honeymoon capital of the world, **NIAGARA FALLS**, Canada.

**Day 18 Niagara Falls - Birch Run**  
We stop at the charming city of **FRANKENMUTH**, famous for its German atmosphere and food. A unique shopping experience is in store for you at **BRONNER'S CHRISTMAS STORE**. Don't miss the **GLOCKENSPIEL** with its 35 Bell Carillon. Tonight you may choose to enjoy their famous chicken dinner, Bavarian style. (Optional)

**Day 19 Birch Run - Iron Mountain**  
Proceeding northward you arrive in the resort town of Mackinaw City. After lunch you cross the **MACKINAC STRAITS BRIDGE** (five miles long).

**Day 20 Iron Mountain - Grand Rapids**  
Your journey continues westward along the north rim of Lake Michigan through the port of Duluth located at the western tip of Lake Superior. The last night of this unforgettable holiday is spent enjoying a **FEHR-WAY FAREWELL DINNER**. (D)

**Day 21 Grand Rapids - Winnipeg**  
Bid farewell to a wonderful Maritime & New England vacation. Saskatchewan passengers overnight in Winnipeg.
