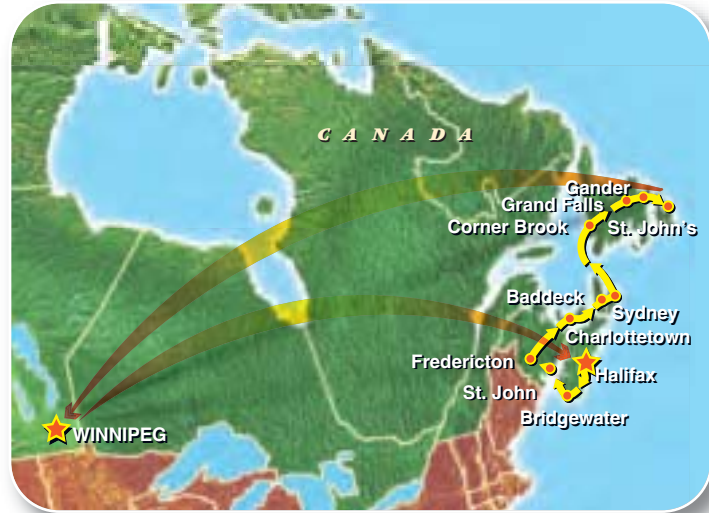

Day 1 Winnipeg - Halifax (2 nights)

Today your Atlantic Canada and Newfoundland Tour begins with a relaxing flight to Nova Scotia. Spend two nights in the beautiful harbour city of Halifax.

Day 2 Halifax Area

The beautifully restored buildings of the Historic Properties along the waterfront, and famed **CITADEL HILL** are among the interesting places you visit on the **TOUR OF HALIFAX** today. Tour **PIER 21 NAT'L HISTORIC SITE**. This afternoon is free to explore. Perhaps a visit to the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic.

Day 3 Halifax - Bridgewater

This morning, enjoy a leisurely drive along the Lighthouse Route to **PEGGY'S COVE** an authentic 19th century fishing village with fisherman's shanties and sea sprayed cliffs. **LUNENBURG**, another attractive coastal town, home of the Blue Nose, the ship portrayed on Canada's dime, and the **FISHERIES MUSEUM OF THE ATLANTIC** are also on your itinerary. Lunenburg is a **UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE**.

Day 4 Bridgewater - Saint John, N.B.

At Digby you board the ferry to cross **THE BAY OF FUNDY** known for the highest tides in the world. In Saint John view the **REVERSING FALLS**.

Day 5 Saint John, N.B. - Fredericton

Today explore **KINGS LANDING**, a meticulous restoration of a village settled by the Loyalists who came here in 1784 after the American Revolution. Then onto in Fredericton, New Brunswick's capital city.

Day 6 Fredericton - Prince Edward Island (2 nights)

Enjoy the coastal views on a morning drive to **FUNDY NAT'L PARK & HOPEWELL ROCKS**, peculiar rock formations which have been carved by the action of the Fundy Tides. Did your coach really roll up **MAGNETIC HILL** near Moncton? The discussion will probably continue all the way across the Confederation Bridge to P.E. I. Enjoy your two night stay on beautiful Prince Edward Island.

Join us on a panoramic journey to experience the spectacular natural beauty and rich cultural heritage of Atlantic Canada & Newfoundland.

Day 7 Prince Edward Island Area
A FULL DAY GUIDED TOUR IN P.E.I.
 includes the fabled **ANNE OF GREEN GABLES HOME**, Cavendish Beach and North Rustico Harbor. In the capital of **CHARLOTTETOWN**, you will be given enough time to visit **PROVINCE HOUSE** and to leisurely wander through the main shopping area of this delightful city. Tonight enjoy one of P.E.I.'s traditional mouth-watering **LOBSTER DINNERS**.

Day 8 Prince Edward Island - Sydney (2 nights)

After a relaxing ferry boat crossing from **WOOD ISLANDS** to **CARIBOU**, you visit the **ALEXANDER GRAHAM BELL MUSEUM** which features the many inventions of its famous namesake.

Day 9 Sydney

Imagine yourself in the highlands of Scotland as you follow the **CABOT TRAIL**, through **CAPE BRETON HIGHLANDS NATIONAL PARK**. It is one of the most beautiful drives in North America with dramatic vistas of mountains, cliffs and forests.

Day 10 Sydney

Visit the **FORTRESS OF LOUISBOURG NAT'L HISTORIC SITE**, the largest historical reconstruction in North America. This park depicts life in an 18th century French fortified town. Before returning to N. Sydney enjoy afternoon tea at **RITA MACNEIL'S TEAHOUSE**.

Day 11 Sydney - Corner Brook

Travel by ferry across the Cabot Strait to **PORT aux BASQUES** in Canada's most easterly province where we will enjoy the warm hospitality of the people.

Day 12 Corner Brook - Grand Falls

Journey through **GROS MORNE**



NATIONAL PARK, which due to its outstanding geology was proclaimed a World Heritage site in 1987. Watch the beautiful terrain abound, as your travels continue into the Bonne Bay area of the Long Range Mountains.

Day 13 Grand Falls - Gander

Enjoy coastline scenery as you drive on the **'ROAD TO THE ISLES'** through the old settlement at **TWILLINGATE**. Here, we visit the museum and the Long Point Lighthouse. In **GANDER**, which became an important airbase during World War II, tour the **NORTH ATLANTIC AVIATION MUSEUM** and visit the Silent Witness Memorial.

Day 14 Gander - St. John's (2 nights)

Spectacular headlands, salmon fishing streams and lakes are features of **TERRA NOVA NAT'L PARK**. Traveling south – arrive early in the provincial capital of St. John's for a two night stay.

Day 15 St. John's Area

A local guide takes us on a **TOUR** of the old seaport city of **ST. JOHN'S**. Begin at **SIGNAL HILL** - the closest point to Europe where Guglielmo Marconi received the first transatlantic wireless signal; the Cabot Tower with panoramic views from the top; lastly the old town and the Basilica of St. John the Baptist.

The afternoon is at your leisure – perhaps an optional cruise to a bird sanctuary (cost not included). Tonight your tour director hosts a unique

FAREWELL DINNER party. Experience the traditional "screech-in" ceremony followed by a festive dinner, the perfect finale to a memorable touring adventure in Atlantic Canada. (D)

Day 16 St. John's - Winnipeg

Board your flight home today with memories of your touring adventure in Newfoundland & Atlantic Canada.
