### Day 5 Washington Area

This afternoon is free to explore the **SMITHSONIAN**, with its Air & Space Museum and the Museum of Natural History.

### Day 6 Washington Area

This morning take in a tour of **MOUNT VERNON**, the graceful mansion of the first American President, George Washington. This afternoon visit the **ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY** and view the Kennedy Memorials and the Changing of the Guard at the **TOMB OF THE UNKNOWN**.

### Day 7 Washington – Lancaster (3 nights)

If you listen closely you can almost hear the roar of the cannons on a **GUIDED TOUR OF GETTYSBURG NATIONAL MILITARY PARK**. This is the site of one of the most important battles of the Civil War which tore America apart in the 1860s. The rolling Pennsylvania countryside leads you to peaceful Lancaster County where you'll experience the hospitality and lifestyle of the Amish people.

### Day 8 - 9 Lancaster Area

Here in the heart of the Pennsylvania Dutch area Amish buggies share the road with cars. During your stay you will be treated to a **TRADITIONAL AMISH MEAL** and have a comprehensive **TOUR** conducted by a local guide.

### Day 10 Lancaster – Akron

This morning you arrive in **HERSHEY**, the Chocolate Capital of the World! See the street lights, shaped like

Hershey Kisses! Visit Chocolate World to see how this famous candy is made.

### Day 11 Akron – Frankenmuth Area

This morning visit the **HENRY FORD MUSEUM**. View the first 'horseless carriage' and many other antique automobiles and artifacts. This afternoon we stop at **BRONNER'S CHRISTMAS STORE** in **FRANKENMUTH**. Enjoy **FRANKENMUTH'S FAMOUS CHICKEN DINNER** this evening. (D)

### Day 12 Frankenmuth Area – Iron Mountain Area

This morning we cross the Mackinac Bridge which connects lower Michigan to its upper peninsula.
