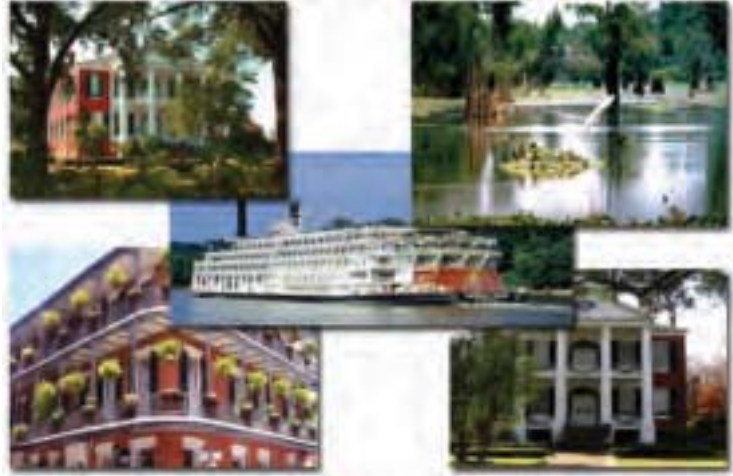

Day 1 Winnipeg – Minneapolis

Day 3 Merrillville – Nashville

Day 4 Nashville – Mobile

Later, travel through Baton Rouge and see the State Capital Building before continuing on to Natchez, the oldest settlement on the Mississippi.

Day 10 Natchez – Vicksburg

Before we leave Natchez, we take a **GUIDED TOUR OF THE BEAUTIFUL ANTEBELLUM MANSIONS** in the area.

Relive some civil war history on a tour of the **NATIONAL MILITARY PARK**.

Day 11 Vicksburg – Branson

The beautiful Ozark Mountain countryside awaits. Continue north through cotton fields before arriving in Branson for the night.

Day 12 Branson Area

While we're in Branson, we'll enjoy a **GUIDED TOUR** of the area. Later today, take in a popular **MUSIC SHOW**.

Day 13 Branson – Kansas City
